Along with her expertise in the field of residential treatment and housing programs, Ms. Khasu is a certified doula and lactation consultant, a trauma-informed yoga instructor, and master-level reiki practitioner.

A self-proclaimed "frustrated farmer that lives in the city" Ms. Khasu is a passionate gardener who also oversees St. Mary's Center's community garden plots.

Prior to joining St. Mary's Center, Ms. Khasu served as the Program Manager for Youth Villages for over a decade, overseeing operations for a residential treatment program serving over 80 families and 100 staff.
